

EVAA 4th Grade Traveling Basketball Program Guidelines

- There will be one team for boys and one team for girls at the 4th grade level.
- There will be a maximum of 10 players per team.
- Tryouts will be held approximately the first week of October.
- Tryouts will be held on one day and last approximately 2- 3 hours.
- All players must be at tryouts to be considered for the team.
- Cuts will be made to fill the roster of 10 players.
- Anyone cut from 4th grade traveling will still be eligible to play in-house basketball for EVAA.
- Practices will begin approximately the first week of November.
- There will be 2 practices per week-generally in the Elementary School gyms.
- The teams will participate in 5 tournaments per year.
- One of those 5 tournaments will include our own Eastview Boys and Eastview Girls tournaments.
- All players will be expected to work in some capacity at the others tournament to fulfill their volunteer hours.
- The initial sign up cost will be the same as all of our traveling team programs.
- The cost of the initial 4 tournaments will be divided among the current roster.
- Participating in our own Eastview Tournament will be free of charge.
- Tournaments (including the state tournament) can be added to their individual schedules as desired by the coach and parents of their respective teams. The additional cost of this will be divided among the participants. Only the players who agree to the additional fee will play in any extra tournaments.
- Uniforms will be provided for each team and returned at season's end.
- Coach selection will be handled through an interview process for all interested candidates.
- The teams will have the same rights and privileges as afforded to all current Eastview traveling policies.
- The season will run from approximately November 1- March 1.

The above rules will apply along with the overall program policies and guidelines.
