EVAA Traveling Basketball Summary

- Open to boys and girls, grades 4-8, who reside in the Eastview High School attendance area and for residents of the City of Apple Valley. [Eastview Athletic Association Participation Policy](#)
- The season runs from October through Mid-March.
- An average of 8-13 weekend tournaments during the season.
- Approximately 2-3 practices per week, including Wednesdays and weekends at Dist 196 schools, Eagan Community Center, Apple Valley Community Center, and other possible sites in Bloomington or Eagan.
- Practices are scheduled to as late as 9:45pm on weeknights.
- Opportunity to participate in Minnesota State Tournament(s).
- Each EVAA basketball parent is required to work a shift our home tournaments (generally girls players and their parents work boys' tourney and boys players and their parents work girls' tourney).

Equipment and Uniforms

- All teams will be provided all the equipment needed for their season.
- All players will be provided a uniform: shorts and jersey(s), which need to be returned at the end of the season to EVAA.
- Logowear will be available for purchase at the Parent/Player meeting.

Cost

- The \$135.00 fee, due at registration, includes the registration, pre-tryout clinic, and tryout fees; insurance and gym time. In the event that you are not placed on a team, all fees will be refunded with the exception of the \$25 tryout fee.
- Tournament fees can vary depending on the number of tournaments played (range \$160-\$250).

- Spectators (parents) of tournament games will be required to pay admission fees except at our own tournament.

Coaches

- Applications for coaching positions will be available at registrations and can be obtained online. They need to be completed and forwarded to The Program Director NO LATER than August 31st. Anyone interested in coaching or have questions can contact the appropriate Program Coordinator. Coaches interviews will be completed by mid-September and applicants will be notified after player try-out selection.
